Understanding who we are is critical to how we live. In other words, identity is essential. Does the church have a particular identity revealed in the scriptures? If so, what is it? What should it look like in the life of a church? Most pressing, are we living out our real identity? Come, let's reason together (Isaiah 1:18) this morning.
